Go to the Vyond website to get started, and complete each of the following:

 Create an account (you have 14 days to complete and download your video using the free trial).

Create a Vyond video with a minimum of 6 slides. It should be between 1 to 3 minutes in length. Be sure that all media you use in the video is public domain, falls under Fair Use, or is associated with the appropriate Creative Commons license. The video should have the following:

- · At least 1 character
- · At least 1 animation using a motion path
- · At least 1 animation not using a motion path
- Use at least 2 props
- Change the actions of at least one character
- Change the emotions of at least one character
- Use of voice over or text to speech throughout the video
- Use at least 2 different backgrounds, one can be a blank background
- · Have a clear message that you wish to convey in your video
- Maintain an audience appropriate tone throughout your video

Upload to YouTube.

You can export the video then upload it to YouTube. If you don't
want it to be public, be sure to make the privacy setting
"Unlisted" – you can then submit the URL and only those with
the link can see it. Include an appropriate title and description of
your video. Select an appropriate category for your video
(typically education). Under the advanced settings, either do not
allow users to add comments and video responses, or change
the setting so they are only allowed with approval.

- 1. Deliverable has been uploaded in the appropriate format, with all required items described (see below), and are fully accessible by the grader.
- 2. The Vyond video (viewed on YouTube) demonstrates professionalism in the following ways:
 - All required items/functionalities have been used and demonstrated as specified in the deliverables list below
 - It is professional in quality and is appropriate to the audience.

- The following items must be displayed in your video:
 - 1. At least 1 character

 - 7. Use of voice over or text to speech throughout the video
